

Medical Scrub Supplier Scoring Sheet

8-point vendor evaluation with weights and what "good" looks like for each criterion.

Score each supplier 1-5 on every criterion. Total each column and compare. Use the "what good looks like" note under each criterion to stay objective across suppliers.

1. Patterns & Sizing (WEIGHT 15%)

CRITERIA	SCORE 1-5	NOTES
What good looks like: explains grading approach, tolerances, and how their blocks are built. Offers XXS-5XL and custom grade rules.		

2. Fabric Guidance (WEIGHT 15%)

CRITERIA	SCORE 1-5	NOTES
What good looks like: recommends fabric by use case (OR vs. general ward vs. dental), gives GSM, composition %, and test data — not just "medical-grade."		

3. Color Control (WEIGHT 15%)

CRITERIA	SCORE 1-5	NOTES
What good looks like: explains single dye lot process, spectrophotometer verification, Delta E tolerance, and how reorders are matched against a retained reference swatch.		

4. Branding Capability (WEIGHT 10%)

CRITERIA	SCORE 1-5	NOTES
What good looks like: clear options (embroidery, heat transfer, DTG), placement limits, costs, and turnaround — not an unconditional "yes to everything."		

5. Sampling Process (WEIGHT 10%)

CRITERIA	SCORE 1-5	NOTES
What good looks like: realistic sample timeline, revision rules, and whether sampling costs are credited against the bulk order.		

6. QC System (WEIGHT 15%)

CRITERIA	SCORE 1-5	NOTES
What good looks like: specific AQL level, inline/end-of-line/pre-shipment checkpoints, batch reports, and spectrophotometer records — not a generic "we QC every order."		

7. Communication (WEIGHT 10%)

CRITERIA	SCORE 1-5	NOTES
What good looks like: direct answers, a named daily contact, fast follow-up, and a clear process for handling mistakes when they surface.		

8. Lead Time Realism (WEIGHT 10%)

CRITERIA	SCORE 1-5	NOTES
What good looks like: timelines match stated capacity, with sample, bulk production, and shipping broken out separately — no wishful quoting.
